**To participate in the poster competition, you must place (postdoctoral fellow), (graduate student) or (undergraduate student) after your name. Abstracts and posters will be reviewed based on scientific merit and relevance to respiratory infectious diseases in two stages, 1) Abstracts will first be evaluated by an Internal Review Committee; 2) For these abstracts selected by the Internal Review Committee, their posters will be judged by the External Advisory Committee.**
